## **JAPANESE KITES: WORKSHOP AND LECTURE**



This workshop will be conducted by Japanese Kite Master **Mikio Toki**. During the lecture, he will introduce the history of kites in Japan, the materials and techniques used to build traditional Japanese kites, and differences in design and shape based on regions.

Participants will learn how to decorate their kite using a traditional Japanese method using dye, and how to assemble it. Step-by-step instructions will be provided.
