## 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic Drone Golf Ball Drop Rules and Regulations

1. Entry fees are \$10 per golf ball, or 6 golf balls for \$50, or 15 golf balls for \$100.
2. The Japan America Society of Southern California ("Charity") 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic Drone Golf Ball Drop ("Drone Golf Ball Drop") will take place during the Charity's 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic on Monday, September 12, 2016 at the La Cañada Flintridge Country Club, 5500 Godbey Drive, La Cañada Flintridge, California 91011. Participants in the Drone Golf Ball Drop may enter more than once. All golf ball numbers will be issued at random to qualifying participants, who will be notified of their golf ball numbers via email following order and payment processing. **A minimum of one hundred (100) golf balls must be sold for the Drone Golf Ball Drop to occur.**
3. On Monday, September 12, 2016, golf balls bearing numbers issued to the participants will be placed randomly in a bucket, flown in a drone and dropped over a marker near the #10 Tee Box at the La Cañada Flintridge Country Club. The participant whose golf ball comes to rest closest to the marker will receive a cash prize of \$500. If it is determined that more than one golf ball comes to rest equally closer to the marker than any other golf ball, the cash prize of \$500 will be split evenly amongst the participants issued such equally closer golf balls. Depending on the lift capacity of the drone, the golf balls bearing numbers issued to the participants may be divided and separately dropped in more than one drop, but in all events, the winner of the cash prize will be determined based upon the location of all dropped golf balls following completion of all such drops. Determination of the winner(s) of the cash prize will be made by the Charity, and such determination, upon completion, shall be final. Odds of winning are based on number of balls sold.
4. The winner of the cash prize will be announced at the site of the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic and need not be present to win. The winner will be notified via phone and/or email in the event the winner is not present at the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic. In addition, the winner will be announced on the Charity's website following the completion of the Drone Golf Ball Drop.
5. If the Drone Golf Ball Drop should be cancelled for any reason at all, including without limitation, insufficient participation in the Drone Golf Ball Drop, cancellation or postponement of the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic, inclement weather, emergency conditions or flight restrictions, or drone malfunctions or other operational failures, all money collected will be automatically deemed donated to the Charity. Charity, La Cañada Flintridge Country Club, and Heli Watch, Inc. are not responsible for any cancellation of the Drone Golf Ball Drop and will not substitute the prize should this occurrence arise.

7. All mail-in and fax-in entry forms must be received with payment in full by 5:00 p.m., Friday, September 9, 2015. Completed, signed and paid in full entries will also be accepted in person at the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic. All entry fees are non-refundable.

A participant need not be a member of the Charity, or a golfer entered to play in the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Japan America Golf Classic, to participate in the Drone Golf Ball Drop.
