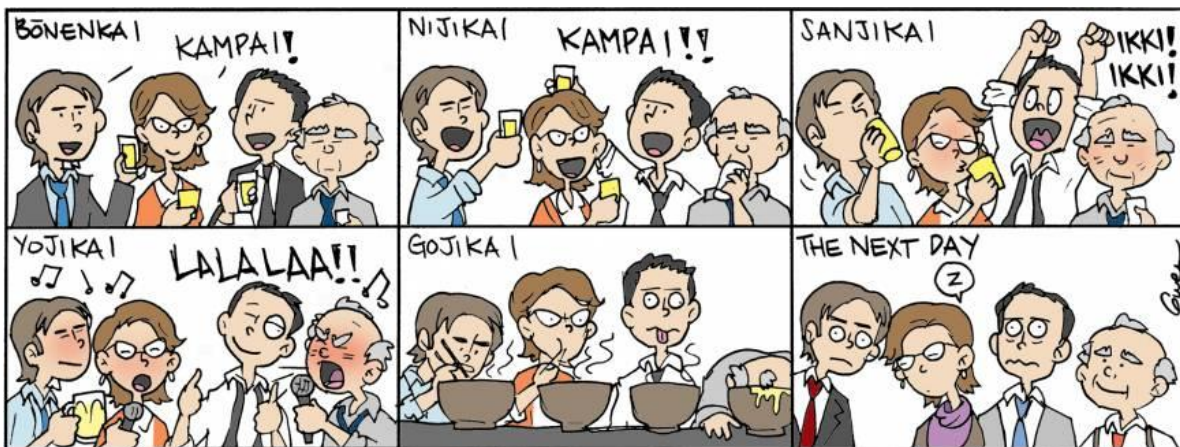




YOUNG PROFESSIONALS END-OF-YEAR *BŌNENKAI* RECEPTION
